Payments:

Meters are now being read beginning the 10th of each month and the bills will be mailed no later than the 25th. **IF YOU DO NOT RECEIVE A BILL BY THE 4TH OF THE MONTH, PLEASE CALL THE OFFICE FOR YOUR BALANCE.** Your bill is due for payment on the 1st of the month. You have until 4:30 P.M. on the 15th to pay without a \$10.00 late fee. Payments may be made on line at www.BentonCityWater.com; by mail; placed in the drop box by the front office door; the drive-through window; or in the office between the hours of 8:00 A.M. to 4:30 P.M.

LATE FEES

If the 15th of the month occurs on a Saturday, Sunday, or Holiday, your payment will not be considered late if: (1) the payment is made in person by the end of the following business day, or (2) if the payment is dropped in the drop box before 4:30 P.M. on the following business day. All other payments will be considered late and will be subject to a \$10.00 late fee.

PAST DUE FEES

If payment is not received by 4:30 P.M. on the last business day of the month a \$30.00 past due fee will be assessed and your service will be disconnected.

(Please refer to "Last Business Day of the Month" schedule.)

To restore services: you must pay your past due bill, late fees and past due fees, and current billing. Late fees and past due fees will continue to accumulate until your account is paid current. After 90 days your meter will be pulled and you will be required to apply for new service – at the current rates.

RETURNED CHECK FEE:

There is a \$25.00 returned check fee. If a check has been returned, on your account, it is necessary to pay by cash or money order for a period of one year.

Water Theft:

Please report any suspicious activity at fire hydrants and flush valves where unauthorized persons may be filling tanker trucks. Benton City WSC reports alleged theft of water to appropriate legal authorities for prosecution.

A \$75.00 fee will be charged if you remove a locking or shut-off device (used to discontinue service), attach objects to the meter to divert or bypass service, or insert objects into the meter.

MINIMUM MONTHLY CHARGES FOR WET METERS:

Each member will be required to pay a \$27.00 monthly fee whether or not they have used water.

MINIMUM MONTHLY CHARGES FOR DRY TAPS (FmHA – RUD) Reserved Service Fee:

When FmHA-RUD loaned Benton City Water the money to furnish water to this area, it was stated that a \$17.25 dry tap monthly fee was required to be paid monthly to reserve service at a specified location. When you choose to go with a dry tap, the meter will be locked and a \$15.00 trip fee will be charged to unlock the meter when you want to begin using the water.
